## 3. Competition Format

In line with the mandate of primarily delivering the Olympic Boxing Qualifying Tournaments and the boxing competition at the Olympic Games Paris 2024, and considering the importance of focusing on the athletes and the short time before the Olympic Boxing Qualifying Tournaments, the Paris 2024 Boxing Unit has considered it appropriate to refer to the Tokyo 2020 Event Regulations, enforced at the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020 and its Qualifying Tournaments, with specific amendments only as and where necessary and/or adequate in this context.

In the interest of sporting fairness, the Paris 2024 Boxing Unit has endeavoured to restrict the amendments to those that increase transparency, fairness and credibility while limiting their impact on the actual sport practice for the Boxers.

The [Paris 2024 Boxing Unit Event Regulations](#) have the sole purpose of applying to all Paris 2024 Boxing Unit competitions, namely the boxing competition at the Olympic Games Paris 2024 and its Qualifying Tournaments.

- Seedings will not be in place for the Official Draw.
- The Official Draw will be conducted by Swiss Timing through an electronic random draw.
- Two rings will be used for part of the competition.
- Medals will be distributed to the top four (4) Boxers of each weight categories (1 gold, 1 silver, 2 bronze).

All times and dates are subject to change according to specific needs and/or force majeure.

## 5. Registration

**All entries for the African Boxing Road to Paris – Dakar must be completed electronically via the Event-Works Registration System (EW) by Friday 28 July 2023 (23:59 GMT+1).**

Before starting the process, National Olympic Committees (NOCs) and National Federations (NFs) must read and accept the terms and conditions of the Organisation Consent and User Account Form, and must complete, sign and return the completed form by email to the WIZ registration team. The form will be shared with all NOCs/NFs in the near future. Only upon receipt of the Organisation Consent and User Account Form, an email will be sent to the registered email address of the NOC/NF containing a link to access the respective EW account.

All entries for Olympic Boxing Qualifying Tournaments require NOCs to confirm the technical and medical standard of the athletes. This means that if an NF has not recommended athletes for participation in the Olympic Boxing Qualifying Tournaments and/or the Olympic Games themselves, the NOC has the authority to enter its athletes without the recommendation of the NF.

### Data to be submitted and verified

NOC/NF designated users are responsible for submitting the personal data on behalf of each member of their Team Delegation, and for ensuring that the personal information provided during the registration application and entries submission is accurate. The following data fields must be completed in EW for all Team Delegation members:

<b>Function</b>	Select the applicant's function from the dropdown list.
<b>Role</b>	If the applicant's function is Team Official or Extra Team Official, select a role from the dropdown list.
<b>Passport Family Name</b>	Enter family name as written in passport.
<b>Passport Given Name</b>	Enter given name as written in passport.
<b>Gender</b>	Select the applicant's gender from the dropdown list.
<b>Date of Birth</b>	Enter the date of birth as written in passport.
<b>Passport Number</b>	Enter the passport number as written in passport.
<b>Nationality</b>	Select the applicant's nationality from the dropdown list.
<b>Passport Country of Issue</b>	Select the country of issue of the applicant's passport from the dropdown list.
<b>Passport Expiration Date</b>	Enter the expiration date of the applicant's passport.
<b>Passport Copy</b>	Upload a copy of the photo ID page of the applicant's passport in .jpg or .png format.
<b>Email</b>	Enter the applicant's email address.
<b>Photo</b>	Upload a photograph of the applicant in .jpg or .png format.

In addition to the fields above, the following data fields must be completed for all registered Boxers:

<b>Preferred Family Name</b>	Enter the athlete's preferred family name.
<b>Preferred Given Name</b>	Enter the athlete's preferred given name.
<b>Athlete Background</b>	Select the athletes' competitive background from the dropdown list.
<b>Event Category</b>	Select the athlete's gender and weight category (see section 5.1) from the dropdown list.
<b>Reserve</b>	Indicate if whether the athlete is a reserve with "Yes" or "No".

Athletes' Preferred Family and Given Names, Date of Birth and Gender provided by NOCs/NFs will be validated by the Paris 2024 Boxing Unit.

Other documents required for participation may be submitted through EW. Please refer to section 5.4 for more information.

## 5.1. Participating Boxers

NOCs/NFs may register a maximum of one (1) competing Boxer and one (1) reserve Boxer for each of the 13 weight categories listed below. The maximum number of athletes that each NOC/NF may enter to participate is 13.

As outlined in the [Qualification System](#) (Section C: Athlete Eligibility), for Olympic Qualification Events taking place in 2023, athletes must have been born between 1 January 1983 and 31 December 2004.

Please note that reserve athletes will not be accredited and allowed to participate unless they replace the primary entered athlete no later than at the Boxing Entries Check.

It is important to select the competing boxer in EW using the Sport Entries module. Please refer to the EW Technical Instructions for more information.

## 5.2. Team Officials

The total number of Team Officials that may be accredited per NOC/NF depends on the number of competing Boxers. Each Team Delegation may include the following accredited Team Officials:

- 1 Team Manager
- 1 Team Doctor (must be registered within their NF)
- 1 Physiotherapist
- Coaches with ringside access:
  - 1–3 Boxers: Up to 3 Coaches
  - 4–8 Boxers: Up to 6 Coaches
  - 8–13 Boxers: Up to 8 Coaches

Each Boxer may be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) Seconds. However, only two (2) Seconds may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.

## 5.3. Extra Team Officials

If a team would like to register any additional Team Delegation members who are not covered by the categories outlined in sections 5.1 and 5.2 (above), they must register them as Extra Team Officials.

Each Team Delegation may register a maximum of five (5) Extra Team Officials, who must either be linked to the NF or be a member of the NOC.

#### 5.4. Submission of Scanned Documents in the System

The following documents must be completed and submitted for each delegation member.

#### 5.5. Boxing Entries Check

The Boxing Entries Check will take place on Thursday 7 September 2023 at the Palm Beach Resort & Spa.

The Paris 2024 Boxing Unit will inform Team Delegations of their exact appointment time prior to the event. The Boxing Entries Check is mandatory for all Team Delegations, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to arrive 10 minutes in advance to meet their appointment. A Team Delegation will not receive its accreditations until it has completed its Boxing Entries Check.

Each Team Delegation may appoint a maximum of two (2) people to attend its Boxing Entries Check. The Paris 2024 Boxing Unit recommends appointing the Team Manager and the Team Doctor.

Team Delegations must provide the following documents for each Boxer, signed and completed as required:

- **Copy of passport**
- **Boxer's Record Book**
- **Conditions of Participation for Participants Form or Parent/Legal Guardian Acknowledgment of Consent for Minors Form**, incorporating the Information Notice on the Processing of Personal Data of Participants and Other Accredited Persons, and the Anti-Doping Rules Applicable to the Olympic Boxing Qualifying Tournaments Organised by the Paris 2024 Boxing Unit Under the Authority of the International Olympic Committee, signed and dated
- **Code of Conduct**, signed and dated
- **Boxer's Medical Certificate**, issued within the previous three (3) months, signed and stamped by a doctor
- **Original laboratory documentation attesting no HIV or hepatitis B+C transmission risk**, no older than one (1) year
- **Declaration of Non-Pregnancy**, signed and dated (women boxers only)
- **Uniform and robe** (if applicable)

**IMPORTANT: Please note that the presence of your representative(s) is mandatory at the Boxing Entries Check. If your Team Delegation's representative(s) do(es) not attend the scheduled appointment, the Team Delegation's registration will not be valid, the Team Delegation will not receive any accreditations and your Boxer(s) will not be able to take part in the competition.**

In order to complete the Boxing Entries process and receive their accreditations, all Team Delegations must have fully paid the LOC for their accommodation by 28 July 2023.



## 6. Qualification System for the Olympic Games Paris 2024

### 6.1. Quota Places

A total of 18 quota places will be allocated at the African Boxing Road to Paris – Dakar, as follows:

## 7. Confirmation of Quota Places for the Olympic Games Paris 2024

The Paris 2024 Boxing Unit will inform the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places within three (3) days of the conclusion of the respective qualification event.

The NOCs will then have two (2) weeks to confirm to the Paris 2024 Boxing Unit if they wish to use the quota places.

If an allocated quota place is not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of quota place deadline or is declined by the NOC, the quota place will be reallocated to the next highest ranked athlete in accordance with the Olympic Games Paris 2024 Boxing Qualification System.

For the avoidance of doubt, the definition of “next highest ranked athlete” refers to the athlete who has lost to the Boxer in question (Boxer who did not accept the quota place or had it denied) in the specific bout that determined the qualification.

## 8. Visa and Entry Requirements

All members of international Team Delegations must present appropriate valid passports and visas when entering Senegal unless they are visa-exempt according to current agreements and regulations. For more information, please visit [www.aeroport-dakar.com/visa\\_on\\_arrival\\_senegal.php](http://www.aeroport-dakar.com/visa_on_arrival_senegal.php).

The LOC will provide visa application support to all athletes, Team Officials and Extra Team Officials. Teams can contact their nearest Senegalese embassy or consulate for visa advice and/or applications.

Individuals and/or Team Delegations who need visa assistance should ensure that a copy of their valid passport(s) is uploaded into EW by Saturday 15 July 2023.

All passports must be valid for at least six (6) months from the date of arrival and must contain blank page(s) for visa(s).

## 9. Transportation

### 9.1. Arrivals and Departures

The official airport for arrivals and departures is Blaise Diagne International Airport (DSS).

All registered persons must submit the following details through EW no later than Friday 4 August 2023:

- Arrival date and time
- Arrival flight number
- Number of bags per passenger
- Departure date and time
- Departure flight number

EW Technical Instructions with further guidance will be shared in v2 of this handbook.

After arriving at the airport and clearing customs, all registered individuals must present themselves at the Welcome Desk within the airport terminal building, where volunteers will be on hand to direct teams to their hotel transfer.

### 9.2. Ground Transportation

The LOC will provide transportation between the training and competition venues and the delegation hotels. Timetables will be displayed on information boards in the lobby of each hotel, where volunteers will be available to provide guidance and information.

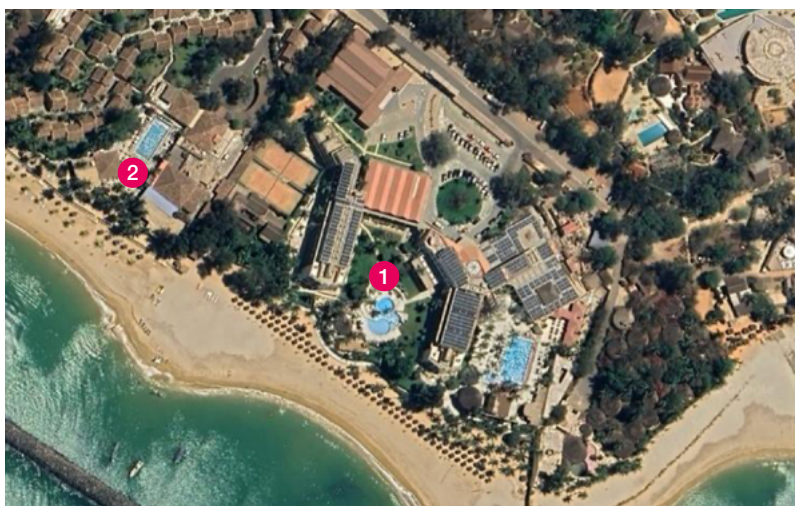
## 10. Accommodation

Both hotels will be located in Saly, approximately 60km (45 to 60 minutes' travel time) from the competition venue.

All Team Delegations are responsible for covering the costs of their accommodation for the entire period of the African Boxing Road to Paris – Dakar (10 nights, 6-16 September). The LOC has secured rooms for the Team Delegations for special nightly rates that include three (3) meals per day.

Team Delegations must submit their room requests to the LOC through the EW system no later than Wednesday 19 July 2023. Please refer to the EW Technical Instructions for more information (shared in v2 of this Team Delegations' Handbook). Team Delegations will then be provided with the LOC's bank details, and must pay the LOC in full for all rooms by Friday 28 July 2023.

Both hotels offer free Wi-Fi and full board accommodation with buffet meals for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. A regular shuttle service will operate from all hotels to and from the competition venue. The hotels are located next to each other, and teams will be able to walk from one hotel to the other.

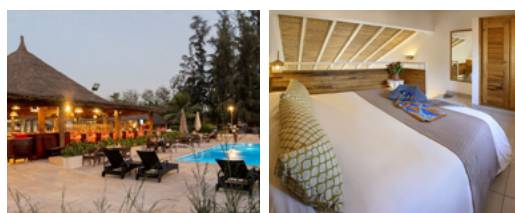

## 12. Equipment & Uniforms

Professional hand wraps, boxing gloves and headgear will be provided by the Paris 2024 Boxing Unit. As per the Paris 2024 Boxing Unit Event Regulations, professional hand wraps are mandatory for both men and women.

For all bouts, Boxers must wear uniforms and/or robes that comply with the Paris 2024 Boxing Unit Event Regulations (refer to rule 13).

Competition gloves and headguards will be provided by Adidas.

Competition rings, training rings and bags will be provided by Taishan.

## 13. Image Rights and Video Recording

A Host Broadcaster will film promotional video and official photographers will take still images of Boxers before and during the African Boxing Road to Paris – Dakar. By participating in the event, each Boxer and Team Delegation member agrees to release his/her image rights to the IOC.

Video recording for broadcasting purposes of any kind will not be allowed.

## 14. Boxing Road to Paris Website

In the lead-up to the seven (7) Olympic Boxing Qualifying Tournaments and the Olympic Games Paris 2024, the Boxing Road to Paris web page will be the key digital location where Boxers and officials can find information about each event and about the Games.

This page will make the road to Paris 2024 as smooth as possible by keeping you updated with the latest developments and providing access to Team Delegations' Handbooks, Registration Forms, Paris 2024 Boxing Unit Event Regulations and Competition Schedules. ## 15. Mandatory E-Learning Course

All athletes must take an e-learning course on the topic of competition manipulation before the event in order to help ensure it is conducted as fairly as possible. Details on how to take the course will be shared by email in the near future.

## 16. Anti-Doping

The IOC Executive Board has decided to extend the application of the existing IOC Anti-Doping Rules for the Olympic Games Paris 2024 to the Olympic Boxing Qualifying Tournaments and the athletes participating in them.

Doping controls will be conducted in accordance with the World Anti-Doping Code. In accordance with World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) regulations, blood testing may be conducted during the African Boxing Road to Paris – Dakar.

Previously existing Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUEs) will be reviewed and recognised if they have been granted in accordance with the International Standard for Therapeutic Use Exemptions (ISTUE; <https://tinyurl.com/ISTUE>). New TUE applications made before the event should follow the normal applications process, and should be submitted to the respective National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO; <https://tinyurl.com/NADOSLIST>).

During the event, TUEs must be submitted directly to the International Testing Agency (ITA) by following the process described at the ITA website: <https://ita.sport/tue>.

## 17. Medical Services

The LOC will provide first aid during the entire event period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the event.

The yellow fever vaccine is mandatory when travelling to Senegal, and all travellers may be required to provide proof in the form of a yellow fever vaccination certificate. The following vaccinations are also recommended:

Vaccination	Summary Information
Hepatitis A	Vaccination lasts 25 years with a booster six (6) months after the original vaccination.
Hepatitis B	In case of transfusion following an accident/exposure to needles/unsafe sex; normally lifelong immunity after completing course.
Meningitis (meningococcal)	Quadrivalent vaccine (serogroups A, C, Y and W135) when travelling during the dry season (December to June) or during an outbreak; lasts five (5) years.
Tetanus booster	If no vaccination within last 10 years.
Typhoid	Vaccination lasts three (3) years, then a booster is needed.

### Malaria

Malaria transmission is seasonal, but the risk of *P. falciparum* exists throughout the year in the whole country. The risk is highest from July to December.

The five principles (**ABCDE**) of malaria protection – it is most important to avoid being bitten by mosquitoes:

- Be **A**ware of the risk, the incubation period, the possibility of delayed onset, and the main symptoms.
- Avoid being **B**itten by mosquitoes, especially between dusk and dawn by using insect repellent, covering your arms and legs, and using a mosquito net.
- Take antimalarial drugs (**C**hemoprophylaxis) when appropriate, at regular intervals to prevent acute malaria attacks.
- Immediately seek **D**iagnosis and treatment if a fever develops one (1) week or more after entering an area where there is a malaria risk and up to three (3) months (or, rarely, later) after departure from a risk area.
- Avoid outdoor activities in **E**nvironments that are mosquito breeding places, such as swamps or marshy areas, especially in late evenings and at night.

*Recommended for chemoprophylaxis (as normally the best tolerated):*

Atovaquone 250mg/Proguanil 100mg combination preparation (Malarone): start one (1) to two (2) days before arrival.

One (1) tablet is taken every day, ideally at the same time of day and daily for seven (7) days after leaving the malaria risk area.

Other options for chemoprophylaxis: Doxycycline 100mg or Mefloquine (Lariam) 250mg.

## 18. Insurance

All accredited participants must have their own travel, medical, repatriation and liability insurance, and must provide proof of this insurance by uploading details into EW no later than Wednesday 9 August 2023.
